FR MORTY UPDATE Last Monday I started maintenance chemotherapy to keep me in remission till I begin the third party bone marrow transplant in mid November. Last Wednesday I met with the consultant who will oversee the transplant. She doesn't see any problem finding a donor whose marrow will match mine. I am likely to be in hospital for a month after the procedure begins. Afterwards I will need to stay at home (with my brother and sister in law) for another 2 months until my immune system sufficiently recovers. If it all works ok, I am likely to have a 2-5 year remission after which there may be newer and better therapies. Hopefully among these will be Car T Cell therapy which is still in its beginning / trial phases. A week ago I started living in and helping out at the Church of the Resurrection in Rye, a little to the north of Bronxville where I was earlier living with my family. FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2021

Congratulations to all the young people of our Parish who received First Holy Communion on Saturday in Frosses, Ardaghay and Mountcharles. Thanks to teachers, parents and all involved in their preparation.

This weekend Pope Francis is launching a pathway towards a Universal Synod of Bishops to be held in Rome in 2023 on the question of 'Synodality'. Each diocese is invited to share in the preparation. The purpose of our phase is to garner a snapshot of how we currently journey together (synodality) and to explore how we could do so more meaningfully in the future. We have a short timeframe – from now until February 2022. You will have an opportunity to answer a number of questions which will be made available at the launch and over the next three months



Bishop McGuckian will launch our Diocesan Phase of the Synod at the 12.30pm Mass in St Eunan's Cathedral, Letterkenny on Sunday 17th October 2021 (www.churchservices.tv/letterkenny).

St Faustina Kowalski's Memorial was celebrated this past Tuesday. At her canonization in 2000, Pope John Paul II reflected that the message of mercy Sister Faustina imparted stood like a "bridge" between the 20th century (one of the most violent in human history – particularly when we consider the legalisation of abortion) and the third millennium. St. Faustina, a Polish nun, was gifted with mystical visions of our Lord Jesus. Her diary (search on AMAZON for DIARY FAUSTINA) records her dialogue with Jesus as He proclaimed His message of mercy: 'Proclaim that mercy is the greatest attribute of God.
